Admission to the Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) Program at NVCC is selective. By successfully completing the necessary prerequisites and other program admission requirements, you **may** be among the students selected for admission to the Spring 2010 class.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Read all the criteria for admission to the PTA Program. Determine whether or not you satisfy these criteria. If you know you will **not** meet all program selection requirements prior to the end of the Fall 2009 semester you are urged to continue your prerequisite (and academic core) coursework and apply to the Spring 2011 class.

Applicants currently enrolled in Anatomy and Physiology I (NVCC BIO*H211) who will complete this course in December 2009 are eligible for conditional acceptance. Official transcripts of final grades must be submitted as soon as they are available. You must successfully complete this required course with a minimum grade of "C" to be considered for admission. All other prerequisite courses for the PTA program must be completed prior to the application deadline to meet the application requirements.

If you believe that you will fulfill all admissions criteria by the conclusion of the Fall 2009 semester, complete this application indicating how the admissions criteria are being met. The Admissions Office will verify applicant information through review of the applicant's entire academic record as it is on file in the Admissions or Records Offices on October 15, 2009.

PLEASE NOTE: This program is provided through a consortium in collaboration with Capital, Housatonic, Manchester, Naugatuck Valley, Northwestern Connecticut, and Tunxis Community Colleges. Individuals applying for admission to the PTA Program at more than one of these colleges will **not** be considered for admission to any program. **Do not apply for admission to this program at more than one college in this consortium.**

Application deadline for January, 2010 entry is October 15, 2009. Admissions decisions will be made in November with a target date for student notification by the first week of December 2009. Applicants who are not admitted to the PTA Program for 2010 and who wish to seek admission in succeeding years must reapply.

New or Transfer Students must submit an NVCC Application along with this Program Application. Current or Former NVCC students need only submit this Program Application.
